SUPPORT SERVICES AT OPEN DOOR

The Open Door program is comprised of Community Support Services (CSS) and the Assertive Community Treatment (ACT) team. Open Door provides community and office-based services for clients living with a severe and persistent mental illness. The program focuses on meeting clients where they are to help them achieve their goals. The CSS and ACT teams collaborate with outpatient programs across Clatsop Behavioral Healthcare (CBH) to ensure that clients receive the support they need to thrive. Services available include case management, peer support, individual and group therapy, medication management, addiction treatment services, supported employment, and skills training.

ASSERTIVE COMMUNITY TREATMENT

Assertive Community Treatment (ACT) is an intensive, community-based program for individuals experiencing severe and persistent mental illness. ACT provides comprehensive services by collaborating and coordinating with CBH outpatient programs, including individual therapy, medication management, and substance use disorder treatment. The ACT team supports clients in living in the community, participating in treatment, and managing their health independently.
