- Referral for psychiatric services*


*The Rapid Access Clinic does not offer medication and detox services. Please speak with your provider regarding referral, if interested in these services.


Adult Mental Health and Substance Use Drop-In Service

The RAC

The Rapid Access Clinic is a voluntary walk-in service for adults (18+) providing case management, peer services, coordination to community resources, and referrals for substance use and psychiatric care. Individuals meet with a skilled staff member who will triage care, with options including meeting with a peer support specialist, a therapist, or receiving an assessment—follow-up services scheduled as appropriate.

Individuals under 18 who need an urgent appointment may visit the Child and Family Services outpatient clinic at 486 12th Street in Astoria during regular business hours.
